The easiest way to use the magnet is to wrap the magnet in tissue paper before stirring it through the cereal. Remove the magnet from the tissue over a white piece of paper. The iron will fall to the paper. For fun, move the magnet underneath the paper and watch the iron change shapes and move around. Have fun, but be careful with the magnet!
