**\* NOTE: While we make every attempt to insure that all the Deluxe Family Lab Supply Kits are as complete as possible, common sense and shipping restrictions dictate that some items are excluded. The customer is asked to supply the following items – water, pen, adult with a knife, empty soda bottles, ingredients for suet (see book for details) stove, pot, freezer, umbrella, cooking oil (a few drops), chicken bone, cow bone, mud, twigs, grass, leaves, lumber/tools for building birdhouse, eggs, lamp, pencil, bowl, items with distinctive odors (see book for details), photo of family member, insects, disinfectant (a few drops), food scraps, banana, needle, tissue paper square, tall glass drinking cup, potato, butterfly larvae (caterpillars), clothes hangers.**

Many families have several children sharing a single book and supply kit. This works great for most of the lessons, but a few of the projects would be much more fun if there were some extra supplies for the extra siblings. The **2<sup>nd</sup> Student Kit** is designed for just that purpose. You will want to add one of these kits for each **ADDITIONAL** student using the text. For example, if you have three children using the same book, add two 2<sup>nd</sup> Student Kits to the base kit.

NOTE: This kit is designed to be used in a family setting with a small number of children sharing all the resources. For bigger groups, like a co-op group, ask for information on our Co-op Supply Kits.

**Additional Notes about the projects contained in the book, *Exploring Creation with Zoology 1*:**

Two identical soda pop bird feeders are included and used in several lessons. You will need to supply empty soda pop bottles. You will use colored tape (included) to change the colors of the feeders as required in Lesson 4.

If you are not able to build a birdhouse by yourself, we suggest that you attend one of the classes offered at home improvement stores like Home Depot or Lowes. Alternately, you may purchase a kit from Creation Sensation with precut/predrilled boards and hardware, made to the exact specifications called for in the text. Check the website for price.

In Lesson 10, the process of making a kill jar is explained. If you wish to make a kill jar, please do not use the jars included in this kit. Instead, recycle a jar from your trash and dispose of it promptly (and safely) after use.

If you are unable to obtain butterfly larvae for Lesson 14 because of location or weather, you may order a certificate to redeem for Painted Lady butterfly larvae from the Creation Sensation website.
