* NOTE: While we make every attempt to insure that all the Deluxe Family Lab Supply Kits are as complete as possible, common sense and shipping restrictions dictate that some items are excluded. The customer is asked to supply the following items – a **large box**, a **long casserole dish or cake pan**, **empty 2 liter bottle w/lid**, **hot and cold water**, a **freezer**, a **pencil**, a **clock**, **vanilla or perfume**, a **lamp (flexible neck is best) with 60 watt bulb and 100 watt bulb**, **dirt**, a **tadpole**, a **goldfish**, a **large bowl**, **distilled water**, **assorted empty bottles**, **small water bottles (3)**, a **cooking pot**, a **fruit popsicle**, a **rose clipping**, and a **stack of books**.

Many families have several children sharing a single book and supply kit. This works great for most of the lessons, but a few of the projects would be much more fun if there were some extra supplies for the extra siblings. The **2nd Student Kit** is designed for just that purpose. You will want to add one of these kits for each **ADDITIONAL** student using the text. For example, if you have three children using the same book, add two 2nd Student Kits to the base kit.

NOTE: This kit is designed to be used in a family setting with a small number of children sharing all the resources. For bigger groups, like a co-op group, ask for information on our Co-op Supply Kits.

Additional Notes about the projects contained in the book, *Exploring Creation with Zoology 2*:

Concerning the Ocean Box project that lasts through the entire course, you will need to purchase some sort of modeling clay to create animals. As an alternative, many families purchase the Creation Sensation **Ocean Box Assortment** of toy animal replicas which provides animals for each lesson. Details are available on the website.

Creation Sensation also has designed a **Seashell Assortment** that mirrors the shells covered in the book. For complete details, consult our website.

Lesson 1 – In place of food coloring, substitute kool-aid. Add the entire packet to ¼ cup of water and use as you would regular food coloring, a few drops at a time.

Lesson 5 - Mix plaster/water in a 2:1 ratio. Add approximately ½ cup of water to each cup of plaster. Don't forget to save the clay for later use.

Lesson 6 – Purchase goldfish, or other temperature hearty fish from local bait shops at pennies each.

Lesson 7 – Don't forget that you need distilled water!

Lesson 12 – You will need to purchase a popsicle containing real fruit for this lesson.

Lesson 13 – Wrap black construction paper around one of the bottles rather than painting it black.
